AMENDMENTS intended to be proposed by Mr. UDALL of  
New Mexico

Viz:

1        On page 34, beginning on line 19, strike “provide de-  
2 fense articles, defense services, and military training” and  
3 insert “provide and transfer weapons designated under  
4 Category I of the United States Munitions List created  
5 and controlled under section 38 of the Arms Export Con-  
6 trol Act (22 U.S.C. 2778), Category III ammunition as  
7 required for authorized Category I items, and defense  
8 services, military training, logistics equipment, and items  
9 necessary for establishing command and control”.

10        On page 36, line 16, strike “(C)” and insert “(D)”.

1           On page 36, line 22, insert “, including the capability  
2 to maintain a chain of custody of assistance being pro-  
3 vided under this section” after “civilian control of the mili-  
4 tary”.

5           On page 36, line 24, strike “; and” and insert a semi-  
6 colon.

7           On page 36, after line 24, add the following:

8                   (C) according to chain of custody criteria  
9                   established and promulgated by the Department  
10                  of State, the individual, unit, or entities to  
11                  whom assistance is being provided can maintain  
12                  a reasonable chain of custody of weapons con-  
13                  sisting of a reasonable capability to document,  
14                  account, and physically control the transfer,  
15                  custody, and disposition of assistance being pro-  
16                  vided under this section; and

17           On page 37, line 1, strike “(D)” and insert “(E)”.

18           On page 37, strike lines 11 through 18 and insert  
19 the following:

20           (c) RESTRICTIONS ON WEAPONS TRANSFERS, IN-  
21 CLUDING ANTI-AIRCRAFT DEFENSIVE SYSTEMS.—

1           (1) IN GENERAL.—The Department of State  
2 shall not be permitted to authorize the transfer of  
3 Category II and Category IV anti-aircraft items des-  
4 ignated under the United States Munitions List, in-  
5 cluding anti-aircraft defensive systems, unless the  
6 President issues the applicable waiver in accordance  
7 with paragraph (2).

8           (2) WAIVER.—The President may waive the re-  
9 striction on munitions transfers under paragraph (1)  
10 if—

11       On page 38, beginning on line 2, strike “together  
12 with the certification” and all that follows through line  
13 5 and insert the following: “together, in the case of Cat-  
14 egory IV anti-aircraft defensive items, the certification re-  
15 quired under subsection (b)(1) specifically with respect to  
16 such items;”.

17       On page 38, line 6, insert “, in the case of Category  
18 IV anti-aircraft defensive items” after “certifies that”.

19       On page 38, line 15, strike “systems” and insert  
20 “items”.

1       On page 39, strike lines 17 through 19 and insert  
2 the following: “Syria;

3               (7) a description of the financial and materiel  
4 resources currently available to opposition forces;  
5 and

6               (8) the criteria for chain of custody certification  
7 and the adherence by the Syrian opposition to chain  
8 of custody requirements.
