AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE intended to be proposed by Mr. NELSON (for himself and Mr. RUBIO)

Viz:

1 Strike all after the resolving clause and insert the fol-

2 lowing: "That the Senate—

3 (1) recognizes that Robert Levinson is the long-

4 est held United States civilian in our Nation's his-

5 tory;

6 (2) notes the repeated pledges by and renewed

7 commitment of officials of the Government of Iran

8 to provide their Government's assistance in the case

9 of Robert Levinson;

10 (3) urges the Government of Iran, as a humani-

11 tarian gesture, to act on its promises to assist in the

1 case of Robert Levinson and to immediately provide  
2 all available information from all entities of the Gov-  
3 ernment of Iran regarding the disappearance of  
4 Robert Levinson to the United States Government;

5 (4) urges the President and the allies of the  
6 United States to continue to raise with officials of  
7 the Government of Iran the case of Robert Levinson  
8 at every opportunity, notwithstanding ongoing and  
9 serious disagreements the United States Government  
10 has with the Government of Iran on a broad array  
11 of issues, including Iran's ballistic missile program,  
12 sponsorship of international terrorism, and human  
13 rights abuses; and

14 (5) expresses sympathy to the family of Robert  
15 Levinson for their anguish and expresses hope that  
16 their ordeal can be brought to an end in the near  
17 future.
