AMENDMENT intended to be proposed by Mr. GARDNER

Viz:

- 1 At the end, add the following:
- 2 **SEC. 15. MEASURES RELATING TO MILITARY COOPERATION**
- 3 **BETWEEN BURMA AND NORTH KOREA.**
- 4 (a) IMPOSITION OF SANCTIONS.—
- 5 (1) IN GENERAL.—The President may, with re-
- 6 spect to any person described in paragraph (2)—
- 7 (A) impose the sanctions described in para-
- 8 graph (1) or (3) of section 10(b); or
- 9 (B) include that person on the SDN list
- 10 (as defined in section 10(g)).

1 (2) PERSONS DESCRIBED.—A person described
2 in this paragraph is an official of the Government of
3 Burma or an individual or entity acting on behalf of
4 that Government that the President determines pur-
5 chases or otherwise acquires defense articles from
6 the Government of North Korea or an individual or
7 entity acting on behalf of that Government.

8 (b) RESTRICTION ON FOREIGN ASSISTANCE.—The
9 President may terminate or reduce the provision of United
10 States foreign assistance to Burma if the President deter-
11 mines that the Government of Burma does not verifiably
12 and irreversibly eliminate all purchases or other acquisi-
13 tions of defense articles by persons described in subsection
14 (a)(2) from the Government of North Korea or individuals
15 or entities acting on behalf of that Government.

16 (c) DEFENSE ARTICLE DEFINED.—In this section,
17 the term “defense article” has the meaning given that
18 term in section 47 of the Arms Export Control Act (22
19 U.S.C. 2794).
