## A BILL

To reauthorize the Global Food Security Act of 2016 for 5 additional years.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Global Food Security  
5 Reauthorization Act of 2017”.

1 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

2 (a) ASSISTANCE TO IMPLEMENT THE GLOBAL FOOD  
3 SECURITY STRATEGY.—Section 6(b) of the Global Food  
4 Security Act of 2016 (22 U.S.C. 9305(b)) is amended by  
5 striking “fiscal years 2017 and 2018” and inserting “fis-  
6 cal years 2017 through 2023”.

7 (b) EMERGENCY FOOD SECURITY PROGRAM.—Sec-  
8 tion 492(a) of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961 (22  
9 U.S.C. 2292a(a)) is amended by striking “fiscal years  
10 2017 and 2018” and inserting “fiscal years 2017 through  
11 2023”.

12 **SEC. 3. GLOBAL FOOD SECURITY STRATEGY IMPLEMENTA-**  
13 **TION REPORTS.**

14 Section 8(a) of the Global Food Security Act of 2016  
15 (22 U.S.C. 9307(a)) is amended—

16 (1) by striking “Not later than 1 year and 2  
17 years” and inserting “During each of the first 7  
18 years”; and

19 (2) by striking “for 2017 and 2018” and in-  
20 serting “at the end of the reporting period”.
