AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE intended
to be proposed by Mr. YOUNG (for himself and Mr. CARDIN)

Viz:

1 Strike all after the resolving clause and insert the fol-
2 lowing: “That it is the sense of the Senate that—

3 (1) the United States should lead an urgent
4 and comprehensive international diplomatic effort to
5 address obstacles in Nigeria, Somalia, South Sudan,
6 and Yemen that are preventing humanitarian aid
7 from being delivered to millions of people who des-
8 perately need it;

9 (2) the United States should encourage other
10 governments to join the United States in providing
11 the resources necessary to address the humanitarian

1 crises in Nigeria, Somalia, South Sudan, and
2 Yemen;

3 (3) parties to the conflicts in Nigeria, Somalia,
4 South Sudan, and Yemen should allow and facilitate
5 rapid and unimpeded passage of humanitarian relief
6 for civilians in need and respect and protect humani-
7 tarian and medical relief personnel and objects; and

8 (4) the United States, working with inter-
9 national partners, should support efforts to hold ac-
10 countable those responsible for deliberate restrictions
11 on humanitarian access in Nigeria, Somalia, South
12 Sudan, and Yemen.
