Expressing the sense of the Senate that any United States-Saudi Arabia civilian nuclear cooperation agreement must prohibit the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia from enriching uranium or separating plutonium on its own territory, in keeping with the strongest possible nonproliferation "gold standard".

AMENDMENT intended to be proposed by Mr. CORKER

Viz:

1 Strike all after the resolving clause and insert the fol-
2 lowing: "That it is the sense of the Senate that any United
3 States-Saudi Arabia civilian nuclear cooperation agree-
4 ment under section 123 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954
5 (42 U.S.C. 2153), commonly known as a '123 Agreement',
6 concluded in the future should prohibit the Kingdom of
7 Saudi Arabia from enriching uranium or separating pluto-
8 nium on Saudi Arabian territory in keeping with the
9 strongest possible nonproliferation 'gold standard' as well
10 as require the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia to bring into force

1 the Additional Protocol with the International Atomic En-
2 ergy Agency.”.
