AMENDMENT intended to be proposed by Mrs. SHAHEEN Viz:

1 At the end of title IV, add the following:

2 SEC. 405. OFFICE OF GLOBAL WOMEN'S ISSUES.

3 (a) SENSE OF CONGRESS.—It is the sense of Con4 gress that the Office of Global Women's Issues (referred
5 to in this section as the "Office") in the Department
6 should—

7 (1) be headed by the Ambassador-at-Large for
8 Global Women's Issues, who should be appointed by
9 the President, by and with the advice and consent
10 of the Senate;

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(2) coordinate, under the direction of the Sec retary, the United States foreign policy efforts to
 promote gender equality and the rights and em powerment of women and girls in United States di plomacy, partnerships, and programs;

6 (3) serve as the principal advisor to the Sec7 retary regarding gender equality, women's and girls'
8 empowerment, and violence against women and girls
9 as a priority of United States foreign policy;

10 (4) represent the United States in diplomatic
11 and multilateral fora on matters relevant to the sta12 tus of women and girls;

(5) advise the Secretary and provide input on
all activities, policies, programs, and funding relating to gender equality and the advancement of
women and girls internationally for all bureaus and
offices of the Department and in the international
programs of all other Federal agencies;

(6) work to ensure that efforts to advance gender equality and women's and girls' empowerment
are fully integrated into the programs, structures,
processes, and capacities of all bureaus and offices
of the Department and in the international programs of other Federal agencies; and

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(7) conduct regular consultations with civil soci ety organizations that are working to advance gen der equality and empower women and girls inter nationally.

5 (b) REPORT.—Not later than 180 days after the date 6 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall submit 7 a report or provide a briefing to the appropriate congres-8 sional committees regarding the efforts of the Office to 9 carry out the duties described in subsection (a).
