6 (4) expresses solidarity with and calls for the 7 release of all political prisoners in Russia and 8 Belarus, as well as Ukrainian citizens illegally held 9 as prisoners by Putin's regime in violation of the 10 rule of law as a result of their support for liberal 11 democratic values; and

(5) calls on the President of the United States
and leaders from across the free world to work tirelessly for the release of political prisoners in Russia
and increase support for those advocating for democracy in Russia, as well as independent media and
civil society which Mr. Kara-Murza has worked to
further.
