Strike all after the resolving clause and insert the fol lowing:

3 SECTION 1. OPPOSITION OF CONGRESS TO SUSPENSION,

4 TERMINATION, DENUNCIATION, OR WITH-5 DRAWAL FROM NORTH ATLANTIC TREATY.

6 The President shall not suspend, terminate, de7 nounce, or withdraw the United States from the North
8 Atlantic Treaty, done at Washington, DC, April 4, 1949,
9 except by and with the advice and consent of the Senate,
10 provided that two-thirds of the Senators present concur,
11 or pursuant to an Act of Congress.

1 SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON THE USE OF FUNDS.

2 No funds authorized or appropriated by any Act may 3 be used to support, directly or indirectly, any efforts on the part of any United States Government official to take 4 5 steps to suspend, terminate, denounce, or withdraw the United States from the North Atlantic Treaty, done at 6 7 Washington, DC, April 4, 1949, until such time as both 8 the Senate and the House of Representatives pass, by an 9 affirmative vote of two-thirds of Members, a joint resolu-10 tion approving the withdrawal of the United States from 11 the treaty or pursuant to an Act of Congress.

12 SEC. 3. NOTIFICATION OF TREATY ACTION.

(a) CONSULTATION.—Prior to the notification described in subsection (b), the President shall consult with
the Committee on Foreign Relations of the Senate and
the Committee on Foreign Affairs of the House of Representatives in relation to any effort to suspend, terminate, denounce, or withdraw the United States from the
North Atlantic Treaty.

(b) NOTIFICATION.—The President shall notify the
Committee on Foreign Relations of the Senate and the
Committee on Foreign Affairs of the House of Representatives in writing of any effort to suspend, terminate, denounce, or withdraw the United States from the North
Atlantic Treaty, as soon as possible but in no event later
than 180 days prior to taking such action.

1SEC. 4. AUTHORIZATION OF LEGAL COUNSEL TO REP-2RESENT CONGRESS.

3 Both the Senate Legal Counsel and the General Counsel to the House of Representatives are authorized 4 5 to independently or collectively represent Congress in initiating or intervening in any judicial proceedings in any 6 7 Federal court of competent jurisdiction on behalf of Con-8 gress in order to oppose any effort to suspend, terminate, 9 denounce, or withdraw the United States from the North 10 Atlantic Treaty in a manner inconsistent with this joint 11 resolution.

12 SEC. 5. REPORTING REQUIREMENT.

13 Any legal counsel operating pursuant to section 4 shall report as soon as practicable to the Committee on 14 Foreign Relations of the Senate and the Committee on 15 16 Foreign Affairs of the House of Representatives with respect to any judicial proceedings which the Senate Legal 17 18 Counsel or the General Counsel to the House of Rep-19 resentatives, as the case may be, initiates or in which it 20intervenes pursuant to section 4.

21 SEC. 6. RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.

Nothing in this resolution shall be construed to authorize, imply, or otherwise indicate that the President
may suspend, terminate, denounce, or withdraw from any
treaty to which the Senate has provided its advice and con-

sent without the advice and consent of the Senate to such
 act or pursuant to an Act of Congress.

3 SEC. 7. SEVERABILITY.

4 If any provision of this resolution or the application 5 of such provision is held by a Federal court to be unconsti-6 tutional, the remainder of this resolution and the applica-7 tion of the provisions of such to any person or cir-8 cumstance shall not be affected thereby.

9 SEC. 8. DEFINITIONS.

In this resolution, the terms "withdrawal", "denunciation", "suspension", and "termination" have the meaning given the terms in the Vienna Convention on the Law
of Treaties, concluded at Vienna May 23, 1969.
