- 1 In section 412, strike “The Secretary of State” and
- 2 insert the following:
- 3 (a) REPORT.—
- 4 (1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 30 days after
- 5 each time the United Nations General Assembly
- 6 modifies the assessment levels for peacekeeping op-
- 7 erations, the Secretary shall submit a report, which
- 8 may include a classified annex, to the Committee on
- 9 Foreign Relations of the Senate and the Committee
- 10 on Foreign Affairs of the House of Representatives.

1           (2) CONTENTS.—Each report submitted under  
2 paragraph (1) shall describe—

3           (A) the change, by amount and percentage,  
4 of the peacekeeping assessment charged to each  
5 member state; and

6           (B) how the economic and strategic inter-  
7 ests of each of the permanent members of the  
8 Security Council is being served by each peace-  
9 keeping mission currently in force.
